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Accessing the site

1. To access the site go to www.learningtrust.com



2. Select Login/ Register.

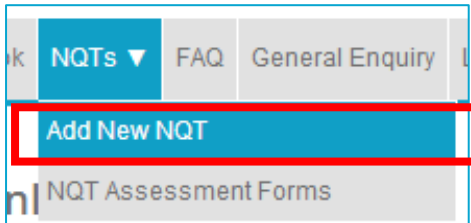
- a. If you already have an account with BLT Online enter your username and password into the 'Sign in' box and press 'Enter'. You can use the forgotten password link if needed.
- b. If you don't have a BLT Online account please contact nqt@learningtrust.net


3. Once you have logged in you can easily change your password by clicking on My BLT Online then go to My Account – Change Username and Password.

Adding a new NQT

1. To add a new NQT select 'Add New NQT' from the 'NQTs' dropdown on the header bar:



2. This will take you to the 'Add NQT' page. Fill in the details and click Save.

3. An email will then be sent to the address supplied informing the NQT of their login details.
4. You will then be taken to the NQT Registration form.
You do not have to complete this form immediately - you will be able to find the NQT's account again (once you are ready to complete the registration form) by searching for them on the Manage NQTs page. **Please don't set up the NQT with a user account again otherwise they will have 2 accounts.**

Please bear in the mind that the NQT cannot undertake any assessments or be registered as an NQT on the National College's Teacher Services site until you have submitted their registration form. Once the registration form has been submitted and authorised by NQT Admin at BLT, the NQT will be able to complete their induction period and will be officially registered as an NQT under Buckinghamshire Learning Trust on the NCTL's Teacher Services site by NQT Admin.

5. Please ensure that you have all the information required to complete all of the mandatory fields (fields marked with a red * are mandatory) on the registration form:

6. The induction end date will be auto populated (therefore can be left blank) **IF** the following 3 conditions apply: The NQT starts their induction period on 1st September, the NQT is working full time and the NQT has not served any part of their induction already. If these conditions do NOT apply please enter the completion date you believe to be correct and put a note in the 'induction end notes' field if you are unsure what the induction end date should be. The NQT admin team will be able to check this field when they authorise the form.

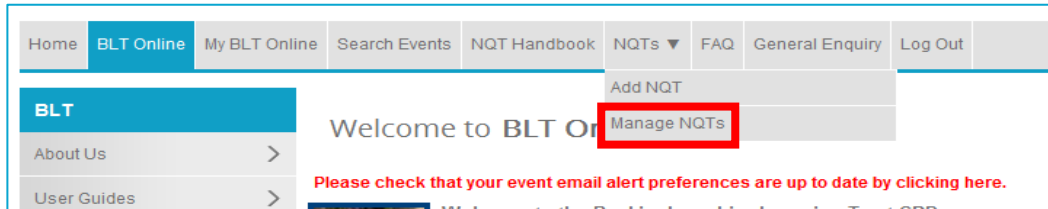

2. In the 'Manage NQTs' box you can leave the fields blank and click 'Search' to return all of your NQTs or search by specific fields. None of your NQTs will appear until you perform the search.

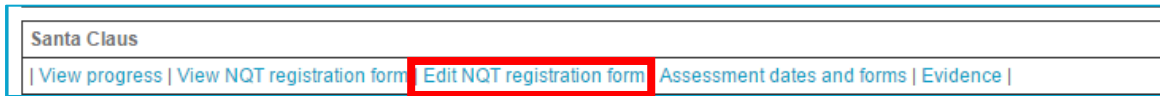
3. If can't find your NQT(s), you may need to amend the range for the induction start date. As the Induction Tutor, you can only see those NQTs in your school who are assigned to you. Headteachers are able to see the records for all the NQTs in the school.

Viewing an NQT's Registration Form

1. From your search, click on 'View NQT Registration Form' to view the registration form of that NQT.



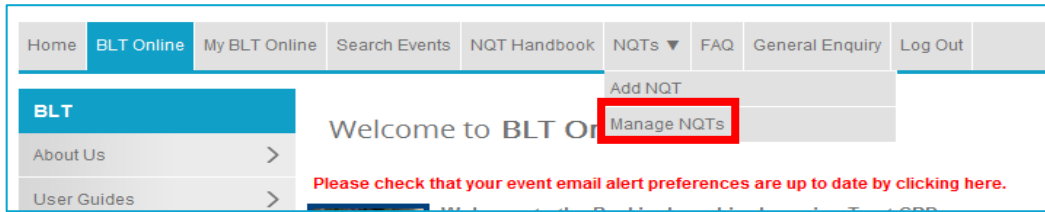
2. Click 'Edit NQT Registration Form' to edit the form. After the form has been authorised by NQT Admin you will no longer be able to edit it. Instead, please email nqt@learningtrust.net to request NQT Admin to make the changes for you.



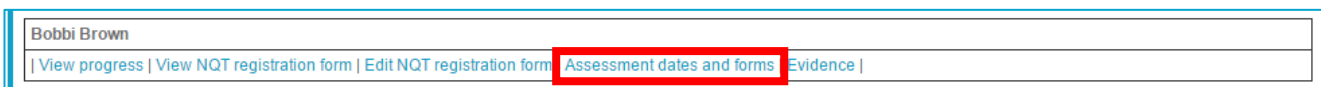
3. If you do make any changes to the registration form before it has been authorised by NQT Admin click 'Save' to save any changes made.

NQT Assessments

1. In order to write/view your NQT's assessments, go to 'Manage NQTs' and click on 'Search' to return all of your NQTs.



2. Click on 'Assessment dates and forms' to write/view an NQT's assessments:



3. Please note, only induction tutors can write assessments for NQTs.
4. Once on an NQT's assessments page, you can see the due dates for the NQT's 3 assessments. If you believe any of these are incorrect please contact the NQT team at nqt@learningtrust.net.

5. Please note you will be unable to move onto the next assessment until the previous one has been completed and signed-off by the NQT, the Headteacher and NQT Admin.

6. Remember to save continuously whilst writing the assessment. The mandatory enforcement for fields will be applied once you have ticked the final confirmation checkbox. **You can continue to write and save the assessment at any point up until the confirmation box has been ticked.**

It will now be sent to the NQT to read and sign off, then to the Headteacher for confirmation and finally to the NQT Admin team for final sign-off, upon which you and the NQT will receive email notification.

NQT Evidence

FAQs

Registrations

1. What happens if I add an NQT but can't complete their registration form straight away?

You can find the NQT you have added by searching for them on your 'Manage NQTs' page. A search will bring up that NQT's name and you can then fill out a registration form for them by clicking on 'edit registration form'.

2. What should I do if my NQT has completed part of their induction period in another school already?

When you complete the registration form you have the chance to add details of an NQT's previous induction history. The NQT Admin Team will see this information when they authorise the registration form. Please then save the NQT's previous assessment(s) in the NQT's evidence section.

3. What should I do if my NQT doesn't know their Teacher Reference Number (TRN)?

All trainees should know their TRN even if they are still undertaking initial teacher training. If they can't remember/ find it, we would advise they speak to their training provider or contact the National College for Teaching & Leadership at qts.enquiries@education.gov.uk or call 0207 593 5394.

The BLT Online system requires you to enter an NQT's 7 digit teacher reference number (it's usually in the format **/***** so ignore out the / and enter the figures with no break) on the registration form before submitting it so that we can ensure you are not registering teachers who aren't eligible to undertake NQT induction. If you have any queries about the eligibility of specific NQTs, including Irish trained NQTs, please contact the BLT NQT team on (nqt@learningtrust.net or 01296 382859).

4. What happens with Overseas Trained Teachers?

Please refer to the guidance on our NQT website at: <http://nqt.learningtrust.net/overseas-trained-teachers.html> or contact us directly if you have further questions on nqt@learningtrust.net. If your NQT trained in Ireland they may be able to serve their probationary period in your school; however this is slightly different from the usual induction so we advise you to contact us on nqt@learningtrust.net to discuss the situation when your school takes on somebody in this position.

5. I'm confused by the 'induction end date' section on the registration form. Help!

The 'induction end date' box can be left blank if your NQT fulfils the following criteria:

1. The induction start date is 1st September
2. The NQT is full time
3. The NQT has not completed any part of their induction elsewhere.

The system will then auto-populate all of the NQT's assessment dates if these conditions apply and the induction end date box has been left blank.

If your NQT does **not** fulfil any of the above 3 criteria, please enter the completion date you believe to be correct (e.g. if the NQT is working at 0.5 FTE, induction will take 2 years instead of 1). You also have the option to comment in the 'induction end notes' box if you are unsure.

The NQT Admin Team will check the induction end date for each NQT registration form submitted and we will then email out the assessment due dates (to you and the NQT) as confirmation.

6. Can I save an assessment form as I go along?

Yes, please do save the form as you go along. If you click save (without ticking the confirmation box) you can return to the form as many times as you wish to edit it. The assessment form is only submitted once you have ticked the confirmation box at the end of the form and clicked save. **Please note that once you have ticked the assessment confirmation box and saved it you will no longer be able to edit the form. We advise you to check the form thoroughly before clicking the confirmation box and saving the form.**

7. What is the sign-off process for assessment forms?

Once you have completed your NQT's assessment form and ticked the confirmation box at the bottom of it, it goes on to the NQT for sign-off, then the Headteacher, then finally the BLT NQT Admin Team. Once the NQT Admin Team has authorised the form, you (and the NQT) will receive notification of this. If it's a successful final assessment, a confirmation letter will be emailed (from the system) to you, the Headteacher and the NQT.

8. What happens when an NQT has completed their induction?

Once the NQT Admin Team have authorised a final assessment, the Induction Tutor, NQT and Headteacher receive a confirmation email. The NQT Admin Team then update the NQT's record on the National College for Teaching & Leadership's website and they (not Buckinghamshire Learning Trust) will email confirmation of successful completion to the NQT directly, along with instructions on how to access their certificate on the NCTL's self-service portal: <https://teacherservices.education.gov.uk/SelfService/Login>

Please note that the BLT does not issue certificates. The NCTL can be contacted on gts.enquiries@education.gsi.gov.uk or 0207 593 5394

You will be able to access the records of any of your previous NQTs' (only those who started the process from September 2014) on BLT Online by selecting 'NQT Induction Complete' (from the dropdown 'NQT stage') in the search box on the Manage NQTs page. The NQT Admin Team can also access all previous NQTs' records in the same way.

9. What should I do if I have concerns about an NQT's progress?

Please contact us in the usual way – by calling us on 01296 382859 or by emailing nqt@learningtrust.net. You will be able to securely store and share any supporting evidence, action plans, lesson observations etc. directly in the NQT's evidence section instead of having to email them to us.
