

# The Primary NQT Professional Learning Programme (PLP) 2016/2017

The NQT Professional Learning Programme (PLP) will equip your NQTs with the essential skills required to kick start their NQT Induction Year.

The four days will provide NQTs with an opportunity to reflect on their current practice, evaluate their teaching and learning, provide a basis to incorporate further ideas and approaches to impact on their teaching from a wide range of peers. The programme will also provide a basis for ongoing professional development and allow them to collate evidence towards meeting the Teacher Standards.

During all four days of the PLP, delegates will be encouraged and supported to develop valuable peer support networks. These networks will be supported to develop classroom practice and link to the range of resources and opportunities provided by the Trust.

There will be four full conference days over the academic year. The sessions will be focused on the specific needs of Primary NQTs following feedback from the 2015/2016 programme and will include ongoing discussion of development as a professional in the first year of teaching.

**Day 1, Welcome to the best job in the world!** An introduction to the world of teaching focusing on key elements such as assessment for learning, safeguarding, behaviour management and classroom environment to ensure a successful early part to the induction year.

**Day 2** will focus on Principles, Pedagogy and Practice. We will cover areas of development such as growth mind-sets, questioning and differentiation. These will take the form of workshops where delegates will decide which sessions will have the largest impact on their teaching.

**Day 3** is a curriculum day where a series of workshops will be held which will be subject specific i.e. primary numeracy, primary literacy, primary reading, cross curriculum planning etc...

NQTs will have the option to pre select the workshops they wish to attend as not all workshops will be relevant to their practice. And each workshop will be run several times to ensure that the NQTs can attend each workshop they wish to.

Each of our sessions will be delivered by subject specialists and include practical, hands-on, active learning. We will also include the NQTs themselves in ideas for the workshops as we would like the day to form a basis of NQTs needs and areas for development.

**Day 4, Here's to the future!** This day will form a series of workshops in the morning focussing on subject leadership, collaborative professional development followed by a celebration in the afternoon where we invite previous NQTs in Buckinghamshire to talk about their NQT+1 experiences.

Schools that have purchased a BLT CPD package for 2016/2017 will be able to enrol all of their NQTs without charge
